

Jews believing in Jesus as Messiah Worldwide

Numbers based on a Council of Jewish Federation survey conducted in 1990 and conversation with Joel Chernoff the General Secretary of the Messianic Jewish Alliance of America. 1967 was the main trigger when God poured out His Spirit anew upon the Jewish people. Today there may be 2 million or more Jews who believe Jesus is the Messiah – though a very conservative estimate is 350,000. The 1990 1.2 million number is comprised of 385,000 Messianic Jews and 815,000 Jews who believe Jesus is Messiah but choose not to be identified with the Messianic Movement. Total # of Jews worldwide may be 20 million or more rather than the 13 million full Jews often cited.
